

Faithful People of Saint Thomas More,

I want to welcome all of those individuals from the Saint Catherine's community who are joining us this weekend. We are glad you are here with us, and are eager to befriend you, and receive the gifts you will share with STM.

As a reminder, I am asking all of us to wear a name tag (available in the Narthex) for our weekend Masses throughout the month of May, as a gesture of charity toward our neighbor.

We are beginning to incorporate some Saint Catherine's items into our own worship experience, and among them is the Saint Catherine's monstrance which we will use for Adoration this weekend, and the installation of the relic of Saint Catherine of Siena, alongside our relic of the cross (underneath our crucifix).

I've learned I still love my wife and I am going to cancel everything, even though I spent \$15,000 on legal fees.

Learn About the MOScholars K-12 Scholarship Program

May 20-21, after 4pm, 9am, & 11am Masses

It's no secret that one of the keys to a dynamic and growing parish is a dynamic and successful school.

In 2021, the Missouri General Assembly established the MOScholars program, a program that provides scholarships of up to \$6,375 per student for children to attend Catholic and other private schools. Already, 8 students at Saint Thomas More School have been awarded this scholarship, and our hope is that many more will apply as it grows.

Although Jerusalem Farm is starting with a focus on Kansas City, they hope this program can be expanded to other areas of the state. If 200 people commit to purchasing a plate (\$40 more than the standard Missouri plate), the proposal can be submitted to the state government for approval. 
Pop Tabs For Ronald McDonald House
