By now, I'm sure you've all heard that Supreme has "raised the bar" on membership requirements for making Star Council. The membership increase has been raised from 5% to 7%, and Double Star goes up to 14%. - ✓ Last spring we solicited lists of names of potential Knights from current members. Of the 100 who were invited to our Open House by Father Don, 19 were able to attend. If you suggested someone who has still not joined, give him a call or just catch him in church, and invite him into the Order personally.
- ✓ All Knights participating in *That Man Is You!* should bring a Form 100 to every meeting. (A good Knight always carries one anyway!) It's traditional to have all the Knights stand up at one meeting, and that might be the perfect time to hand a potential member a Form 100.
- ✓ If a gentleman isn't sure about joining right now, ask him to look at the Knights of Columbus pages under Community Life on the STM website. All the activities listed are enough to impress anyone that our council is truly a fun, service-oriented group that they'd want to join. There's an email link to the Grand Knight for more information, and we gained one of our new members that way!

A lot of important activities are coming up in October: the MR Drive, Columbus Day Spaghetti Dinner, Knights' Night Out on Columbus Day, and a restart of the golf cart shuttle for the Masses, so I hope you can all participate and join the fun! Be watching for a meeting reminder next week for more details!

Candidates should arrive no later than 12:30 PM, and the degree will start at 1:00 PM. Carpooling will be available from STM parking lot.

The ceremonies take about 3 hours, but are well worth the time, and include a great meal. The cost for the meal is only \$5 (the council covers the cost of the degrees). The hall cannot sell alcohol on Sundays.
