We did it!! Despite the bar being raised from 10% to 14% and starting out with three suspensions, our council has again grown enough to qualify us for our third consecutive Double Star Award! Our net gain this fraternal year was 15 additional members (Star quota 7) and 5 Insurance members (Star/Double Star quota 3). Congratulations to all of you who recruited one or more members this year!

Of course the Star/Double Star award is also based on programs during the year, and, thanks to your efforts, we were able to shine in that area as well! From the MR Drive to Knights Night Out, from Roses for Life to the Family Fun Knight, we continue to have a very active council. If you haven't assisted or participated in any of our activities, I strongly encourage you to not miss out any longer. As I like to tell new Knights after their First Degree, the honor starts with becoming a Knight, but the fun starts with getting involved in council activities!

Although we have a short breather from major activities this month (no parish-wide birthday celebration this year), we can't ever let up on our recruiting efforts. The bar has been raised again this year, so will we need at least 9 new Knights this fraternal year just to make Star Council. With three more unavoidable suspensions pending, that means we'll need a total of 21 new members to achieve our fourth consecutive Double Star. That's just 3 more than our total new members last year, so I know we can do it!

Although it takes most of the afternoon (plus a free dinner), the Second and Third Degree is definitely the most interesting, and carries some additional benefits: Third Degree Knights are qualified to be council officers, and to officially be called "Knights." Technically, First Degree members are "Members of the Knights of Columbus." Taking the degree in September also qualifies you to take the Fourth Degree, which is always in April. Fourth Degree bestows some wonderful benefits, which I'll talk about later.


