## From Father Justin

Faithful People of Saint Thomas More,

First, a word of gratitude from me as your pastor.

For the last 200+ days, the COVID-19 pandemic has left little of our lives untouched. Many of us have been impacted directly, with loved ones hospitalized or even succumbing to complications from the virus. Some in the parish have been furloughed for a period, or lost their employment permanently. Many of us have quarantined for a stint, canceled travel plans or postponed celebrations. The effects are far reaching.



In response, our STM parishioners have stepped up, allowing us to pivot in these uneven times and afford - often in new and untried ways - opportunities for worship, the education of our young, and the healing balm that is the gathering as a community.


# Our values as a faith community
